



## **Sporting Achievements for Academic Year 2018 - 19**

### **September 2018**

Sadly, cross country was cancelled due to bad weather. We are hoping the Heber will re-schedule this event.

The Year 6 pupils had their OAA curriculum for PE at Robinwood. They had an amazing time, participating in various team challenges, zip wire and raft building.

Well the rugby season got off to a flyer! Our Year 5 and 6 team went into the tournament as defending champions. They won their group comfortably, winning all four of their games.
